2026.20 Chair's Welcome

Cllr Halkon welcomed everyone to the Meeting.

2026.21 Apologies

- apologies had been received from Cllr C. Bird and from the Clerk
 - apologies had also been received from Ward Cllrs Cary, Hammond and West
- NOTE: in the Clerk's absence, the Minutes were taken by Cllr Halkon.

2026.23 Public Participation

*To resolve that the Meeting is suspended for a period of up to 15 minutes to allow for Public participation. **Please note that discussion is not permitted during this session.***

The reason for holding an Extraordinary Meeting was explained to those attending, and the following points were raised;

- there are 48 operational solar farms in the East Riding, with another 300 in the pipeline, which constitutes a total change in the East Riding landscape
- the proposal takes a lot of high-quality arable land out of production
- the disruption at Allerthorpe from solar farm development has been going on for 3 years
- why not put the solar panels onto rooftops?
- viewpoints across The Wolds from Londesborough would be ruined
- what is the decommissioning plan, is the cost in 60 years hence written into the proposals?

NOTE: two members of the public were in favour of the proposals as farmers are under pressure to make a profit and solar provides trouble-free electricity.

2026.24 Humberhead Solar

To consider the below request from the Planning Inspectorate regarding the application by Humberhead Solar Limited for an Order granting Development Consent for the proposed Humberhead Solar development;

The applicant has asked the Planning Inspectorate on behalf of the Secretary of State for its written opinion (a Scoping Opinion) as to the scope, and level of detail, of the information to be provided in the Environmental Statement relating to the proposed development.

Before adopting a Scoping Opinion, the Planning Inspectorate must consult the relevant 'consultation bodies' defined in The Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009 (as amended).

The Planning Inspectorate has identified Nunburnholme with Kilnwick Percy Parish Council as a consultation body which must be consulted before adopting its Scoping Opinion. The Planning Inspectorate would be grateful if you would:

- inform the Planning Inspectorate of the information you consider should be provided in the Environmental Statement, or*
- confirm that you do not have any comments*
